

Section XII. Continuance of Obligation.

Any permit issued pursuant to these regulations shall be deemed an obligation upon the property on which the encroachment is located and shall bind successors of the permittee. The permittee shall, however, remain personally responsible to the District for all the burdens imposed by the permit, unless the permittee has advised any successor as to the existence of the permit and obtained for the benefit of the District an assumption of the obligations of the permit by an acceptance executed by the permittee's successor.

This permit shall be deemed a continuing obligation of the permittee until released by District. Upon transfer of all or any portion of the land subject to this permit, permittee shall remain responsible to District for compliance with all terms of the permit, unless the purchaser from permittee executes an Acceptance of the permit in the form set forth below:
